

Use of weapons and pyrotechnics in film shoots

Through the Government
Delegation in the Balearic Islands





For the use of **weapons** in public shows, including film shoots, the application must include:

- Information about the shoot (date, location, reason, etc.).
- List of participants with their tax identification number (NIF/NIE), weapons to be used, serial number, category and ownership of the weapons.
- Planned security measures (transport, use during filming, safekeeping when not in use during filming).





Please note that:

- a) The application must be submitted at least 15 working days in advance. If all the documentation is not provided, the application must be corrected within 10 working days.
- b) During the application process, DO NOT TICK the box "Use of muzzle-loading weapons and black powder". This will allow for a shorter and more simplified procedure.
- c) It is advisable to submit an application for each municipality in which the weapons are to be used, in order to speed up the application resolution process.
- d) The Government Delegation will request a report from the Mayor (or councillor responsible for public safety) regarding the use of weapons in the filming.

If a permit is required for the use of weapons, the fee will range from €40 to €100, **as a guideline.**
